3. Athletics Meet 2017 (P4 – 6)

The Athletics Meet 2017 will be held on Fri, 17 Feb 2017 from 7.15am to 12noon at the Singapore Polytechnic.

The heats for the 100m, 200m and 300m events will be held on the Thu, 2 Feb 2017. There will be no heats for 600m and 4x100m relay (time finals on 17 Feb 2017). Students who are involved in the heats will receive a consent form to inform them of the details of the heats.

A separate letter will also be sent regarding the logistical arrangements for the Athletics Meet finals. Only Primary 4 to Primary 6 students are required to attend the Athletics Meet.

Primary 1 to Primary 3 students need not attend school on that day. Separate lower primary games will be organised for them in the later part of the year.

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5. The value of being punctual

Every morning, we gather for assembly either at the Lower ISH (P1-P2) or the school hall (P3-P6). From 7.10 – 7.25 a.m. the students do “silent reading”. At 7.25 a.m. we sing the anthem, and this is followed by the pledge-taking. The first period is expected to start at 7.30 a.m. The school is monitoring those who come late, and we will take remedial action against those who are late for no reason. It is important that our children learn at a young age the value of being punctual. My teachers and I would like to appeal to all parents to help us in this.

6. Traffic Issues

We would like to appeal to parents to help the school ensure a safer and smoother traffic flow. Please follow the instructions given by our staff when you drop your child and refrain from arguing with them. They are there to ensure the safety of the students.

In the morning, if there is a build-up at Level 3, you may drop your child at Level 1. Please also note that only a right turn is allowed at level 1 exit. Lately, we have observed many parents making illegal left turns from level 1 exit and there have been many near misses. For the safety of yourself and other motorists, we strongly appeal to you to adhere to the traffic guidelines.
