5. Road Safety

Recently, a motorist contacted the school. As she spoke she was in a frantic state. She had nearly knocked down a HPPS student.

My staff and I are very concerned about our students' safety. After school, many are seen with parents, grandparents and their helpers dashing across Holland Grove Road to the opposite side. They do not use the pedestrian crossings.

It is very dangerous to dash across the road. We seek the help of everyone to role model the right behaviour. It is important for children to learn that they should use the pedestrian crossings at all times. This will ensure their safety when they are not accompanied by adults.

On the school's part, we will continue to remind our students to use the pedestrian crossings. Our school staff are also on duty to watch out for the students.

6. Primary 1 (2018) Registration - An update

At the end of Phase 2B, 255 out of 300 P1 places have been filled. The remaining 45 places are for Phase 2C. The school expects all 45 places to be filled. There will be 10 P1 classes in 2018.
