1. Character Value for Term 4 - Excellence

The character value for Term 4 is Excellence. Through the assembly and FTGP periods, we hope to introduce to students the various aspects of Excellence.

Below is a brief outline of the outcomes for the character value for Excellence. We hope that parents will lend their support and partner the school in our efforts to bring out the best in our students by reinforcing at home the following outcomes:

P1/2 – Students will learn to develop self-discipline, exercise self-control as well as demonstrate good sportsmanship.

P3/4 – Students will learn to reach out for their personal best in their undertakings, to behave as a responsible team player and work towards a common goal.

P5/6 – Students must learn to persevere when faced with challenges and find ways to overcome them and carry out appointments and duties to the best of their understanding and abilities.

2. PSLE Listening Comprehension Examination (15 September 2017)

The P6 students will sit for the PSLE LC Exam on Friday, 15 Sept 2017. On this day, the P1 to P5 students are not required to attend school.

3. PSLE Written Examinations (28 September to 4 October 2017)

The P6 students will sit for the PSLE Written Examination from Thursday, 28 Sept to Wednesday, 4 Oct 2017. They will be allowed to leave school at the end of the examination.

Here are some reminders:

- P6 students who are exempted from Mother Tongue paper are not required to attend school on Monday, 2 Oct 2017.
- P6 students who are not taking Higher Mother Tongue paper are not required to attend school on Wednesday, 4 Oct 2017.
- All P6 students are required to report to school as usual on Thursday, 5 Oct 2017.
- The school will function as usual for all primary 1 to 5 students during the PSLE Written Examination.

4. Children's Day Celebration (Thursday, 5 October 2017)

The school will celebrate Children's Day on Thursday, 5 Oct 2017. There is no change to the school time.

P1 - P6 students will have a joint Children's Day Celebration (10.30 a.m. - 12.00 p.m.). We would also like to thank the Henry Park Primary School Parents' Association (HPPA) for their support.

On this day, all P1 to P3 students will be participating in Lower Primary Games Day. The estimated duration of the event for P1 and P3 students will be from 7.30 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. The P2 students will have their event from 12 p.m. to 1.30 p.m. Students can come in their PE attire and sports shoes.

Parents are cordially invited to the Lower Primary Games Day. Do note that there will only be standing space at the venues. Parking will not be available within the school compound.
