Dear Parents and Guardians,

## 1. Opening Remarks

Thank you for your support and cooperation in the recent security measures to enhance the security of the school. We appreciate the feedback which you have given us. These inputs have helped us to make changes to avoid unnecessary inconveniences and at the same time, not compromise the enhanced security that we wish to foster. Some parents have commended the school in helping to implement the changes through various platforms. We appreciate the kind encouragement. One parent shared her child's writing with us, and in relation to the security measures that we implemented this term. The child wrote that *"great things take time to build"*. We thank her for sharing and also to all our parents for your support in this endeavour. The security measures are an on-going process and we hope that you will continue to work together with us to keep our school safe and secure.

The second term is also a period where our pupils will compete and showcase their talents in the many platforms nationally. While we share the teachers' and pupils' joy when they achieve in these platforms, we also want to celebrate those who may not have achieved what they set out to achieve but nevertheless, have given their best. Where time permits, the school leaders have tried to support the children's efforts by being there at these platforms. We have seen in person in the past months our boys and girls competing in sports such as Badminton, Football, Track and Field and Gymnastics, in aesthetics during the SYF for the dances, String Ensemble, Chinese Orchestra and Choir, and our uniform groups such as Girls' Brigade during the award ceremony. It always warms our hearts witnessing our children giving their very best as they pursue their interest and passion. We have seen our children uphold the school values of Respect, Integrity, Care and Excellence. For this, they are all champions in their own unique ways. Another heartening sight for us is witnessing the many parents who have taken time off to volunteer their services and who have been there for our children every step of the way in their trainings and competitions. Your support and belief in the teams means a lot to our children, my staff and me. Thank you parents.

We also have had good conversations with our important stakeholders – parents (during the briefings in T1), HPPA, Alumni and SAC. We are indeed encouraged by their warm support. We can expect to see, through the collaboration, some new learning opportunities for our pupils. We will share more when these ideas become more concrete. We would like to extend our heartfelt thanks to our stakeholders who complement the school by aligning with the school's objectives, supporting and strengthening the school's programmes to improve our children's well-being and holistic learning.

## 2. P1 (2019) Registration

Phase 1 is a priority phase for siblings of students currently studying in Henry Park Primary School and who are Singapore Citizens/Singapore Permanent Residents.

The internal survey for the P1 Registration Exercise has been given out. Parents who have indicated their intention to register their children for admission under Phase 1 will receive a carbonised registration form in May 2018 for completion. This form is to be returned to the school through your eldest child before the start of June vacation and an acknowledgement slip will be given to you. The school will register these children during the Phase 1 registration dates, 28 and

29 June 2018 and parents are not required to be present for the registration. A copy of the carbonised form will be returned to parents in July 2018 after the registration.

### **3. Healthy Meals School Programme (HMSP)**

HMSP is a joint initiative by MOE and Health Promotion Board to cultivate healthy eating habits among students. Besides other measures, this also involves promoting a balanced diet, that is, to make food in the 4 food groups available in the main meals. This balanced diet includes (i) brown rice and whole meal bread (20%), (ii) fruit (1/2 serving), (iii) 2 heaped dessert spoons of vegetables, and (iv) meat and others (tofu, beans, lentils) in main meals.

We look forward to your continued support in cultivating healthy eating habits amongst our children. At times, we have noticed our children not wanting to eat their vegetables and fruits. The school will continue to educate the pupils about the benefits and importance of eating healthily. We would like your support in encouraging your child(ren) to form these good habits. We believe these habits will positively impact their lives beyond their schooling days.

### **4. Traffic Issues**

The traffic outside HPPS has always been a challenge. We have always been looking at ways in managing the traffic situation. We are grateful as we have parent volunteers who help our staff each day to manage the traffic for the benefit of the stakeholders of the school and the community that the school is situated in. It has been observed that some parents stop or park at the junctions of Holland Road and Mount Sinai Drive, the accesses of houses or at spots which can cause traffic congestion. During dismissal, while many motorists are queuing to get into the school, there could be instances when your vehicle could be obstructing traffic flow and thus, causing congestion. At such times, our staff or volunteers would approach the driver to move the vehicle. We seek your understanding and for you to follow their instructions. While we may not totally eradicate the problem, we can strive to minimise the inconvenience to other road users as Holland Grove Road is a public road that is shared by all road users.

### **5. SA Examination**

The P3-P6 students will be sitting for their SA1 written examination soon. Please refer to the schedule of examination dates sent to the parents earlier in the year.

If your child / ward is absent for an assessment, his/her subject teacher will pass the assessment papers for your child / ward to attempt them as practice. It will not be counted as part of the Semestral Assessment (SA). Marks will be pro-rated for pupils who submit their medical certificate (MC). A mark of zero will be given to pupils who are absent without a reason deemed valid by the school.

We will also like to inform that the school will not be conducting any make-up for the written papers examination except for the P4 for Subject-Based Banding purpose. Please do not hesitate to discuss with the Form or Subject Teacher of your child / ward should you have any concerns regarding his/her learning progress.

As our students prepare for their examinations, we hope our parents would continue to affirm their efforts and help us in ensuring their well-being. We would like to wish all students the best for their examinations.
