Dear Parents of P5 students,

We hope that you and your child had a good June break. Below is an overview of the activities and events planned in Term 3.

1. Remedial Classes (Mainstream)

Remedial classes will resume in Term 3 Week 2 on Mondays and Tuesdays from 1.45 pm to 3.45 pm. Selected students will be informed by the form/subject teachers in Week 1.

2. Assessments (Mainstream)

Term Reviews will be conducted at the end of Term 3. They are formative in nature and do not carry any weightage. The actual dates and topics will be communicated to you and your child on a later date.

3. Young Investigators' Project (Mainstream)

The Young Investigator's Project (YIP) is part of the school Science curriculum. The objective of the YIP is for students to experience scientific inquiry in an authentic context. P5 students will get to explore and practice process skills as prescribed in the Primary Science Syllabus (2014). In addition, they will learn to work in teams, do research online and manage their time.

The YIP has commenced and will continue from Term 3 Week 1 to Week 5. Students are expected to work on their projects during Science lessons. They are not required to meet outside of curriculum time to complete their YI projects. Students are also strongly encouraged to use recyclable items for their experimental set-ups. We seek your cooperation and support in this valuable learning experience in the following ways:

- Allow your child time to think, explore and work on the project independently.
- Provide support in the form of guidance and encouragement in meeting all deadlines and gathering of materials or resources.



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- Do not complete the project for your child. For the project to be a true learning experience, it is imperative that the work is completed by the child.
- Allow your child to access MC Online from home where learning resources will be uploaded and updated. Students who are unable to access MC Online at home, can do so in school at the computer labs after seeking permission from their Science teacher.

4. National Education Show

We will be attending the National Education (NE) Show on Saturday, 8 July 2017. Students are strongly encouraged to attend the event as a part of their school experience. We look forward to your child's support. More details will be provided on a later date.
