

Nominations for Edusave Character Award 2019 is now open

MOE introduced the Edusave Character Award (ECHA) in 2012 to allow schools to recognize students who demonstrate exemplary and outstanding character. The implementation of this award seeks to foster a more gracious and inclusive society amongst our young. At HPPS, the award supports our goal in recognising students who have internalised and demonstrated our school values of **Respect, Integrity, Care and Excellence (RICE)** and have lived up to our school motto of '*Honesty in Performance and Pride in Service.*'

The objectives of ECHA are:

- i) to send a clear signal from MOE that importance is placed on a student's character and values.
- ii) to recognize outstanding students who are exemplary in character, who can be good role models and an inspiration to their peers.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1) Only **Singaporeans** who have met the selection criteria decided by the school.
- 2) Nominated students must have demonstrated good character and values **on a consistent basis**. They can be good role models and be an inspiration to their peers

At HPPS, the selection criteria is based on students:

- 1) demonstrating of the school values (RICE) and living up to the school motto
- 2) possessing a high level of civic responsibility; and
- 3) displaying qualities associated with resilience

Students can be nominated by staff, parents or their peers. Forms can be downloaded via the link in our website and submitted to the General Office by **14 August 2019.**

Nominated students will be shortlisted and may be required to present themselves to an interview panel.
